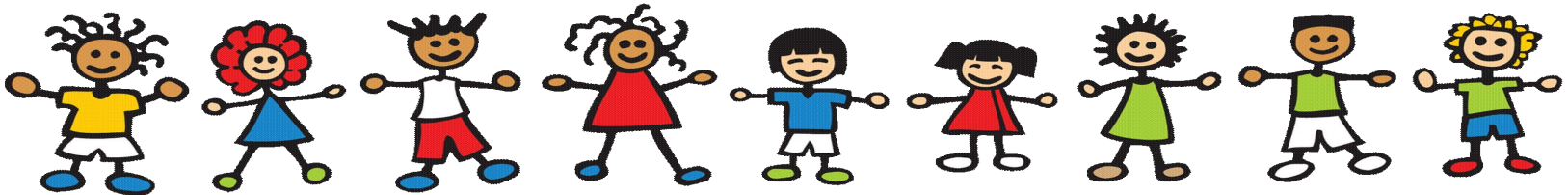

General Information

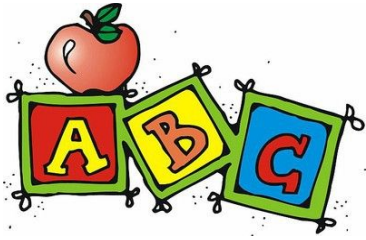
- EZSchoolPay Prepaid Meal Program - for breakfast or lunch purchases

- School starts promptly at 7:55 am, after that, please go to the office for a tardy slip before going to class.

- Complete Parent Orientation packet forms and return them by testing date, small group date at the latest

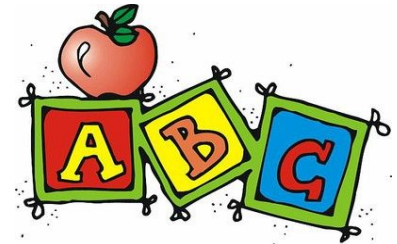


Daily Reminders

and Be Responsible at all times.

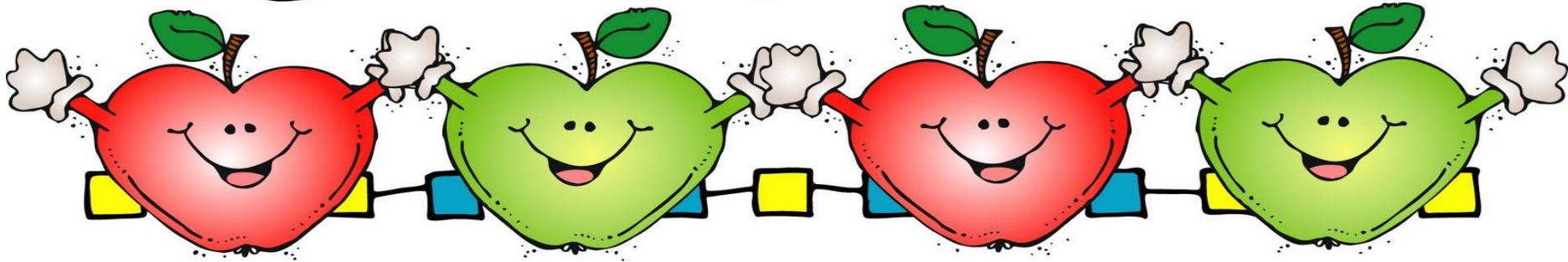
Requests from the Kindergarten Teachers
